

Cozy Bottle Sleeves



A nice bottle of wine is a popular holiday gift – add flair by dressing it up with the most unexpected of accessory. Felted sleeves from bright colored sweaters slip perfectly onto the bottles for a charming touch. Finish the look with a cheerful bow and glittery ornament for an added touch of sophistication.



You Will Need:

From Savers/Value Village

- Wool sweater (at least 80% wool, 100% works best); makes two sleeves
- Small glittered toys (download Glitter Goodies instructions), or faux berry or leaf accents, jingle bells, etc.

Other supplies

- Coordinating ribbon
- Scissors
- Optional
 - needle and thread to match sweater

Directions:

- 1) Felt the sweater (see Sweater Scrap Ribbons project for instructions), and it will come out with shrunken sleeves.
- 2) Measuring from the edge of the cuff toward the armpit, cut off the sleeve, ensuring it is long enough to completely cover a wine bottle. Once the sleeve is removed, trim up the bottom edge for a straight line.
- 3) Slide the sleeve over the bottle, with cuff at top. Tie ribbon around bottle neck and accent as desired with glitter toy, faux berries/leaves, jingle bells, etc.
- 4) Optional Finish – if you'd like to secure the bottom, do so by turning the sleeve inside out and seaming the bottom edge with needle and thread.
