

BECOMING A PIRATE

Ahoy, matey! So ye' wantin' to be a pirate for Halloween? That's a fine choice for a landlubber, and Savers will have you looking like a true buccaneer faster than you can say yo-ho-ho.



You Will Need:

(Available at Savers)

- Spirit Gum adhesive
- Spirit Gum remover
- Black creamy costume make-up
- Pirate eye patch
- Pirate wig and head wrap (sold as set)
- Clip-on pirate hoop earring

Other supplies

- Light colored foundation make-up
- Dark foundation make-up (slightly darker than natural skin tone for tanned look)
- Dark mascara
- Make-up sponge
- Make-up brush or paint brush
- Bottle cork
- Match or lighter
- Coffee grounds

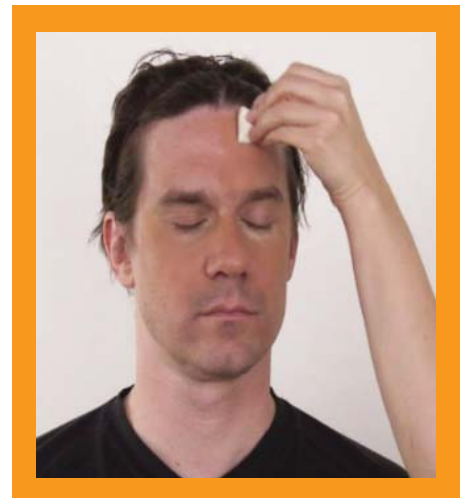
How to Apply Make-up:

Step 1: tan weathered skin

- Start with clean dry face
- Dab light colored foundation under each eye using make-up sponge
- Apply dark foundation over remainder of face with sponge; work in short downward strokes (concentrate primarily on upper part of face, as lower part will have scruff)

Note: When applying new products to the skin, always do a small test patch first to check for allergies; people with latex allergies should not use latex make-up sponges.

BECOMING A PIRATE CONTINUED...

Step 2: facial scruff

This step involves an open flame and should be completed by adults only.

- Char one end of cork by waving a lit match over it for 2-3 seconds (do not light cork on fire); let cool to touch
- Lightly rub charred cork onto face in quick downward strokes, covering beard area and extending into sideburns
- Lightly brush Spirit Gum over beard area; let dry 1-2 minutes until tacky
- Dip brush into coffee grounds and apply over beard area; use brush to press grounds into skin versus brushing them on (use Spirit Gum Remover to help remove beard at end of night)



Step 3: dark eyes

- On one eye, apply black make-up in thick strokes under eye and on eyelid; use fingers or brush and smear to look messy
- Wiggle mascara through both eyebrows to make them bushier and slightly standing up



Step 4: accessorize and touch-up

- Add eye patch
- Add wig and head wrap
- Add clip-on earring
- Apply dark up foundation under scruff to blend neckline
